From 3:00 to 5:00 p.m.

Directions: Main entrance to Hillman Marsh is at Mersea Road 2 and County Road 37. From Point Pelee: Take County Road 33 (Pelee Drive) out of park. Turn right (east) on Road D for 2 km to stop sign at Mersea Road 19. Turn left (north) and go about 3.5 km. Turn left (west) on Mersea Road 1 and go approx 200 m. Turn right (north) on County Road 37 (Hillman Drive) for about 1.5 km. Turn right (east) on Mersea Road 2, entrance to Hillman is on right. From main parking lot take walking trail to shorebird cell. Hillman Marsh is open daily from dawn to dusk.

Admission: Daily entry fee \$6 at self serve kiosk or purchase annual pass or Hillman Marsh Spring Pass from Conservation Authority staff at Hillman entrance from noon to 5:00 p.m. every day from May 1-20. Hillman passes also on sale at Point Pelee Visitor Centre gift shop. Three-day combination Festival of Birds Point Pelee-Hillman passes on sale at Point Pelee gate.
