WORKSHOP

Northbound Shorebirds with Jean Iron

Saturday, May 12 at 11:30 a.m. and Thursday, May 17 at 12 noon
Point Pelee National Park Visitor Centre Theatre

This workshop details 28 regularly occurring spring migrant and breeding shorebirds, **plus** 8 rarer species that migrate through southern Ontario to their Arctic breeding grounds. It is loaded with tips to sharpen identification skills.

The focus will be on Point Pelee area shorebirds, and later we will visit Hillman Marsh Shorebird Cell where Ontario Field Ornithologists (OFO) experts will help with shorebird identification from 3:00 - 5:00 p.m.
